


#### Easter Food Basket Blessing



There is a custom in Poland for families to bring baskets of food to church to be blessed by the priest on Holy Saturday. We have continued this custom here at Holy Family. There will be a blessing of food for the Easter meal on Sat. April 23rd at 12 Noon (Holy Saturday). The baskets usually

contain colored eggs (that symbolize life, spring, and the Resurrection), sausage or ham (that represents the passion of Christ), bread or Babka (that represents Christ, who is the bread of life), horseradish (representing the passion of Christ), salt (symbolizing prosperity), and butter (that represents good will). The decorations of the basket represent joy. Other additions can be candy and wine. The blessed food is eaten Easter morning after Mass.
