

Dear Parishioners,
 We consider Pentecost Sunday, which ends the season of Easter, as the birthday of the Catholic Church. That first year, traditionally 10 days after the

Ascension of Jesus into heaven, the apostles had gathered in Jerusalem with Mary, the Mother of God, and other disciples beside themselves to observe Shavuot, the Feast of Weeks -- a Jewish holiday held fifty days after the Passover Sabbath, to celebrate the midseason grain harvest. (Pentecost, "the fiftieth day," is a Greek translation of the Hebrew Shavuot)

It probably wasn't much of a celebration. Jesus' disciples were confused, unsure what to do next. They probably grieved their teacher and friend, and they were likely anxious about their personal safety. Yet what happened during this feast day transformed them.

Around the world, there are traditions that commemorate Pentecost. In Italy, people scatter rose leaves from the church ceiling to recall the miracle of the fiery tongues. In France, trumpets are often blown during Mass to recall the sound of the mighty wind that accompanied the Descent of the Holy Spirit.



RE-REGISTRATION

Re-Registration Forms may be returned in person or through the mail to the Religious Education Office at: P.O. Box 56, Keyport, NJ 07735.

Please make any necessary corrections and include the non-refundable registration fee as follows:

1 Child \$100.00 2 Children \$150.00 3 or More \$180.00

Re-Registration MUST be received before June 14, 2011. After that date NO-re-registrations will be taken until AFTER August 29, 2011. A \$50.00 late re-registration fee would be due at that time, and the student will only be accepted if there is available room in the grade they are entering in September. **No registrations will be taken over the phone.**

NEW REGISTRATIONS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family MUST be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office now thru June 14, 2011. Begins again August 29th thru September 8th. See below for dates & hours.
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated above for each child.
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
