

Dear Parishioners,
 We celebrate Fathers' Day this weekend. As we honor our dads, let us also support them with our love for all of them, support for those still among us, and prayers for those deceased.

It is also Trinity Sunday. From the earliest days of the Church, the apostles referred to the Holy Trinity of God. This belief is enshrined in the central worship of the Church, the Eucharistic liturgy, i.e., the Mass. At Mass, the priest celebrant can choose this option as the official greeting: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all." Early Church scholars (the "Church fathers") aided the early Church councils to clarify the theology of the Holy Trinity; eventually, a dogma of the Holy Trinity was declared. First, the Trinity is One, one God in three persons. Second, the divine persons are really distinct from one another: God the Father is Creator or Source; God the Son is Redeemer; God the Holy Spirit is Advocate and Teacher. Third, the divine persons are relative to one another and are distinguished by the ways in which they relate to one another. According to Lateran Council IV in 1215, it is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds. "The Father is related to the Son, the Son to the Father, and the Holy Spirit to both" (Council of Florence, c.1438). The Trinity is the basic core or central belief of all who are truly Christian.


