Dear Parishioners,

A Catholic tradition is abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent and on Ash Wednesday. Practicing abstinence or abstaining, in the general sense, means voluntarily doing without food, drink, or some

other pleasure. But for Catholics, it's a specific requirement: Catholics must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on every Friday of Lent and fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics under the age of 14 do not have to fast at all as well as Catholics older than 59, but all are expected to abstain from meat on those days. Fasting only applies to Catholics who are 18 through 59 years old.

Our bishop, the Most Reverend David O'Connell, explained all the above quite clearly in the bulletin letter insert of two weeks ago.
