Dear Parishioners.

Even though our current secular culture may think nothing of experimenting with sex before marriage, the Church says that true love means wanting what's best for the other person -- body and soul. Having sex before or outside of marriage, whether it's a one-

night stand or a longtime cohabitation, isn't sanctioned or blessed by God and lacks respect for the people involved. True love and respect mean you'd never want to lure the one you love into a sinful situation any more than you'd intentionally lead that person into a scenario that would endanger his or her life or health. So having sex supposedly just to show your love is considered a lie.

Engaging in sexual intercourse without a lifelong commitment blessed by God is also dishonest. Sex without a lifelong commitment is a pretense of the most intimate union that only marriage can actually accomplish. Having sex before or outside of marriage is considered dishonest to the people involved, because they deserve only the best, and the best is the total gift of self -- lifelong commitment, fidelity, and openness to the possibility that God may use this couple to bring a new human life into the world.
