

Dear Parishioners,

To Catholics, faith isn't something you find. It's a gift from God. He offers it freely to anyone and everyone, but it must be freely received as well. No one can be forced to have or accept faith. And when it's presented, each individual responds differently --- at different levels, at different times, and in different ways.

A large and sad majority of parents of our nearly 700 religious education students from within and without our parish boundaries see that their sons and daughters are sent to weekly religious instruction at Holy Family's Hazlet site on Tuesday and Wednesday sessions, but themselves do not set the example of attending and participating weekly at communal worship, the Mass, with those same sons and daughters, or at all, on the Union Beach side of Highway 36.

Some reject faith, some ignore it, and most treat it casually and when convenient. Yet, there are fine examples in our parish of God's children, both young and old, who quietly and assiduously, regularly, "religiously," fulfill their Sunday worship obligations at Mass and are mindful of their duty to live their faith among family, friends, acquaintances, and strangers every day, not just on weekends at church. A few find the time and make the effort to supply their parish with volunteer help through ministries, humbly and generously going the "extra mile" in their faith; they apparently cherish their Faith deeply.

As the adage goes: For those who believe, no explanation is necessary, and for those who do not believe, no explanation is possible.
