

HOLY FAMILY PARISH BASKETBALL

Holy Family is fielding a BOYS 5th/6th grade and both BOYS and GIRLS 7th/8th grade basketball teams for the upcoming season. The league runs from mid-November to mid-February with about 18 games against other Parishes and Catholic school teams in the area. Practice and some games will be played at the Holy Family gym. The remainder of the games will be at surrounding Catholic schools or Parishes. The price will be around \$100 per player. Practices will begin in October.

It is a competitive league, so playing time will be based on player ability and practice participation. We will also work to minimize conflicts with school and travel teams, so travel players are invited to participate.
