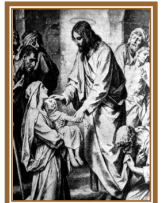

Dear Parishioners,

A convalidation ceremony is needed when a Catholic couple gets married in a civil or non-Catholic ceremony, which makes it an invalid marriage in the eyes of the Church. Even if only one of them is Catholic, it's invalid, because Catholics must follow Church law. If two baptized but non-Catholic Christians get married, however, in a civil ceremony or any religious denomination, the Catholic Church does recognize that as being valid as long as it's the first marriage for both of them.

After six months or more, if a couple decides to have their civil marriage recognized (sometimes erroneously called having it "blessed") by the Catholic Church, then a convalidation is in order. This is a simple and private ceremony involving the couple, two witnesses, a handful of guests or family, and the priest, deacon, or a bishop. The vows are pronounced and the rings may be exchanged. If the rings can't be removed, then they're simply blessed. It's not a renewal of vows but a making of the vows for the first time and with the sanction of the Church. The convalidation makes a merely civil, legal marriage a Sacrament of Matrimony.

Getting married in a banquet hall where the restaurant's or banquet hall's management "finds" or "hires" a priest for the couple is totally inappropriate and usually involves a defrocked, laicized, or rogue "rent-a-priest" whose ability to officiate at a marriage may be legal in the eyes of the state but is an invalid marriage according to the laws of the Church. Any priest or deacon who officiates at a sacramental, valid Catholic marriage must be a priest or deacon who is actively under the authority of the local bishop and have the permission of the area's local Roman Catholic church parish pastor.

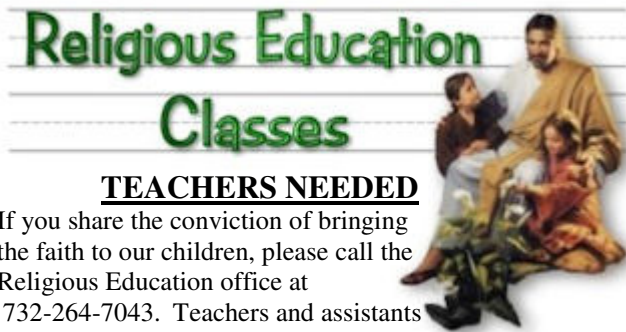


MISSIONS
