Dear Parishioners,

The Sacrament of Marriage is a covenant, which is more than a contract. Covenant always expresses a relationship between persons. The marriage covenant expresses the relationship between the wife and husband, a permanent union of persons capable of knowing and loving each other and God. The celebration of marriage is also a liturgical act, appropriately held in a public liturgy at church. Catholics are urged to celebrate their marriage within the Eucharistic Liturgy, i.e., the Mass, except possibly when they have already been cohabitating (i.e., living together as husband and wife before their marriage), unless they both receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation shortly before their nuptial Mass and ceremony and then refrain from premarital sex, so as to be in the state of grace as they wed. Engaged couples living together before the reception of sacramental marriage as a non-married couple generally should opt for a simple ceremony, however.
