Dear Parishioners,

Confession liberates us from sins that trouble our hearts and makes it possible to be reconciled to God and others. We are asked to look into our souls and, with an honest and

unblinking gaze, identify our sins. This opens our minds and hearts to God, moves us toward communion with the Church, and offers us a new future.

In confession, by naming our sins before the priest or bishop, who represents Christ, we face our failings more honestly and accept responsibility for our sins. It is also in confession that a priest or penitent can work together to find the direction needed for the penitent to grow spiritually and to avoid sin in the future.

When we have carefully examined our consciences and taken responsibility for our sins, we then confess them to the priest or bishop. We must confess our mortal sins in kind and number. The Church strongly recommends confessing venial sins, though this is not strictly necessary. In the Latin Church, children must go to confession before making their First Communion.
