Parents with children in our religious education program will receive their re-registration forms by hand from their children (check their folders) THIS week April 16th AND 17,th for the 2013-2014 school year. Please make any necessary corrections, SIGN and return the form, including the non-refundable

registration fee, as instructed in the letter by May 30, 2013.

NEW DIOCESAN REQUIREMENT

SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY. You may also send it in through your child in April or drop it off to our SCHOOL office May 6th thru May 30th, 9:30 am to 3:30 pm. Front door, ring bell. Fees increase June 3rd thru June 27th. Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 27th, your child will have to wait for the 2014-15 year.

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 17th AND Wednesday September 18th 2013. No other notice will be sent home to you. Class assignments will be posted on those days.

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- Family <u>MUST</u> first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- **2.** Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- 4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
