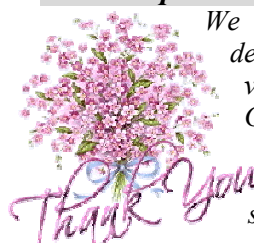
**FIRST COMMUNION STUDENTS
