Confirmation is the second sacrament of initiation and is associated with the other two sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism and the Holy Eucharist.

When adults are received into the Church, they receive the sacraments of

initiation in the traditional order: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist.

The practice of the western (Latin) Church is to baptize children as infants, to allow them to receive the Holy Eucharist for the first time at about age seven and to allow them to be confirmed between the ages of twelve and seventeen.

The sacrament of Confirmation was instituted by Christ when he conferred the Holy Spirit on his apostles and others and then later more strikingly on Pentecost.


