SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 4:32-35

This passage describes the actions of the first community of Christians. They were of "one heart and one mind." They had no rich or poor among them, for they shared all necessary items with one another.

Second Reading: I John 5:1-6

John explains that we become God's children by believing in Jesus. When we love God and concern ourselves only with pleasing God, our faith is strong enough to conquer the evil in our world.

Gospel: John 20:19-31

Jesus appeared to the disciples despite locked doors, breathed on them so that they could receive the Holy Spirit, and gave them the power to forgive sins in his name. Thomas, who was not present, refused to believe without seeing Jesus for himself. Jesus appeared again when Thomas was present, and told him, "Blest are they who have not seen and have believed."

We ask that you please register in the parish office anytime between 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday and between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. Fridays. We hope you will become involved in one of our many ministries here at Holy Family. Please feel free to contact the parish office with any questions or concerns you may have at 732-264-1484.

Below are just some of the ministries you may be interested in participating in:

- **Adult Altar Server Ministry** – Assist our parish priest with funerals – usually morning hours.
- **Choir Ministry** – Do you like to sing? The choir practices every Wednesday at 7:30 p.m. in the church choir loft and sings at the 11 a.m. Mass each Sunday and on special Holy Days of the year.
- **Youth Choir** – Ages 7 to 18. Sings on designated Sundays at the 9 a.m. Children’s Mass. Please arrive 15 minutes before Mass for practice.
- **Altar & Rosary Society** – Women 18 and older are invited to join this ministry which meets every fourth Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. in Memorial Hall for prayer, taking care of the altar, fellowship, fundraisers, etc.
- **Compassion Ministry** – Assist those whose are grieving in choosing their readings and music and notating ways their loved ones are remembered.
- **Golden Age Group** – Young adults 55 and up are invited to Memorial Hall on alternate Monday mornings to join in fellowship, trips, bingo socials, and more.
- **Altar Server Ministry** – Grades 3 and up assist our Priests at Mass, Funerals, and weddings.
- **Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist** – Distribute the Eucharist during Mass.
- **Usher Ministry** – Assist in taking collection, seating, and greeting our parishioners and visitors.
- **Tarscisius Ministry** – Volunteers take Communion to the shut-ins and the hospital.
- **Religious Education Program** – You may volunteer as an aid, teacher, assist in baking goods for fundraisers, etc.
- **St. Vincent de Paul Ministry** – Volunteers assist in the food pantry, thrift ship, making calls to those in need, or delivering food.
- **High School Youth Ministry** – All high school aged teens are invited to join this ministry that meets every Sunday at 6 p.m. in Memorial Hall. Our teens get involved in service projects, fellowship, trips, fundraisers, etc. Call Adele at 732-610-4169.
- **Wednesday Adoration** – 8:30 a.m. to 3p.m. Come and sit in silent reflection before the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament anytime from 8:30 until 3p.m



DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Today we celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy, as requested by Jesus, on the Sunday after Easter. During the 1930's Jesus appeared many times to Sister Maria Faustina Kowalska (1905-1938), a poor, uneducated nun in Poland. He brought with Him wonderful messages of mercy for all people. In her 600 page diary, Divine Mercy in My Soul, St. Faustina kept record of these visits along with her thoughts, reflections and experiences. He also asked her to paint His image, and inscribe it "Jesus, I Trust in You". This feast of devotion focuses on a powerful but simple message.

1. God is merciful and forgiving, but we too must show mercy and forgiveness.
2. God loves us no matter how great our sins.

The simple **ABC** message... **A**sk for His mercy, **B**e merciful, **C**ompletely trust in Jesus



Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

- 1 Begin with the Sign of the Cross, 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and The Apostles Creed.
- 2 Then on the Our Father Beads say the following: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- 3 On the 10 Hail Mary Beads say the following: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
(Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades).
- 4 Conclude with (three times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
