FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 6:1-7

During the early growth of the Church, the apostles realized that they needed more disciples in order to carry out effectively the ministry of the Church. The community selected seven men, one of whom was Stephen.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:4-9

Citing many uses of the word "stone" in the sayings of Jesus and in the Old Testament, Peter urges the Christians to be "living stones...an edifice of spirit."

Gospel: John 14:1-12

In this beautiful passage from the words of Jesus at the Last Supper, Jesus promises that he is preparing a place for the apostles. He tells them, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through me." When Philip asks Jesus to show them the Father, Jesus answers, "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father."



RE-REGISTRATIONS

Parents with children in our religious education program received their re-registration forms **by hand from their children for the 2014-2015** school year. Please make any necessary corrections, **SIGN** and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, **or promissory note by May 29, 2014: SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. DO NOT MAIL REGISTRATION TO THE SCHOOL use P.O. BOX ONLY.** You may also drop it off to our **SCHOOL** office (Front door, ring bell) May 5th thru June 30th, **call for hours. CLOSED FRIDAYS** Fees increase June 2nd thru June 30th. **Absolutely no re-registrations will be taken after June 30. Your child will have to wait for the 2015-16 year. NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.** Classes begin on Tuesday September 16th or Wednesday, September 17th 2014, or shortly thereafter, depending on your child's grade. First grade begins Sunday, October 5, 2014. No other notice will be sent home to you. Class assignments will be posted on those days. **PLEASE READ YOUR LETTERS CAREFULLY!**

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child:
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150
3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

Scholarship will be paid directly to the school of choice.




