
### Second Reading: Ephesians 5:21-32 or 5:2a, 25-32



# NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

### 1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00


- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
