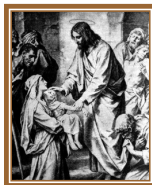

Dear Parishioners,
Bells summoned people to churches starting in the sixth century before the invention of beeping wristwatches. An altar server starting in the thirteenth century would ring a bell so that the people would know that the celebrant priest, with his back to the people and praying inaudibly in a dead, though ecclesiastically revered, language unknown to 99.9% of the congregation, was lifting the host during the recitation of the words of Jesus at the Last Supper. One thousand years ago people came to Mass primarily for adoration, not for eucharistic communion, and so it was important that they try to peer reverently at the host when it was elevated. Today we emphasize the importance of everyone's participation in the Eucharist. We can see and hear and participate in the Mass without having the distraction of bells to remind us to look up and pay attention to the Eucharistic Liturgy.
