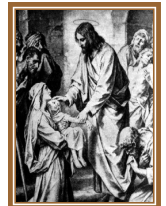

Dear Parishioners,
 God instituted marriage in paradise, and Christ raised it to a Sacrament. In this Sacrament, Christ joins man and woman in a holy and indissoluble union and enables them to share in the mystery of the love between Christ and his Church by conferring graces to fulfill their roles as husband, wife, and parents.

Catholics who choose to live together or "cohabitate" as husband and wife without the benefit of marriage choose to live in a state of serious sin, and are a source of public scandal. Divorces are common although always unfortunate, but are not sinful as such. Remarriage after a divorce without a Church-sanctioned annulment (which declares that the marriage was not really sacramentally valid when it was contracted) is also seriously wrong.

In addition to sanctifying grace, a Catholic marriage gives that special grace needed to remain faithful to the duties of the married state. Married people are expected to live in love till death; help one another live good Christian lives; and teach their children about God and his special love, care, and concern for them.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION RE-REGISTRATION

Re-Registration Forms may be returned in person or through the mail to the Religious Education Office at: P.O. Box 56, Keyport, NJ 07735.

Please make any necessary corrections and include the non-refundable registration fee as follows:

1 Child \$100.00 2 Children \$150.00 3 or More \$180.00

Re-Registration MUST be received before June 14, 2011. After that date NO-re-registrations will be taken until AFTER August 29, 2011. A \$50.00 late re-registration fee would be due at that time, and the student will only be accepted if there is available room in the grade they are entering in September. *No registrations will be taken over the phone.*

NEW REGISTRATIONS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office now thru June 14, 2011. Begins again August 29th thru September 8th. See below for dates & hours.
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated above for each child.
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
