to having and caring for children are essential for marriage.

The remarriage of persons divorced from a living, canonically lawful spouse is not permitted by God's law as taught by Christ. They remain members of the Church but cannot receive Holy

Communion. They are called and encouraged to lead Christian lives by attending and participating in Sunday Mass and cooperating as far as possible in the life of the parish and to bring up their children in the faith.

When divorce is the only possible recourse, the Church offers her support to those involved, and encourages them to remain close to the Lord through frequent reception of the Sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist. In the case of those who have divorced legally or civilly and remarried, even though the Church considers the second marriage invalid, she does not want these Catholics to be alienated from her.






