**Catholics consider Pentecost Sunday, which ends the season of Easter, as the birthday of the Christian Church. That first year, only a few weeks after the Ascension of Christ, the apostles had gathered in Jerusalem with Mary, the Mother of God, to observe Shavuot, the Feast of Weeks—a Jewish holiday held fifty days after the Passover Sabbath to celebrate the midseason grain harvest. (Pentecost, “the fiftieth day,” is a Greek translation of the Hebrew Shavuot.**

**RE-REGISTRATIONS 2012-2013**

Parents with children in our religious education program should have received their re-registration forms **via mail by March 3rd, for the 2012-2013 school year.** Please make any necessary corrections and include the non-refundable registration fee **as instructed in the letter by May 31, 2012.**

**NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.**

**NEW REGISTRANTS FOR 2012-2013**

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as follows:  
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150 3 OR MORE \$180**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

**REGISTRATION DATES & HOURS:**

Beginning May 14<sup>th</sup> thru May 31<sup>st</sup> the Religious Education Office hours are from 9:30 a.m. through 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. **OFFICE IS CLOSED FRIDAYS.** After June 1, contact the religious education office at 732-264-7043 to arrange for an appointment to register. Classes begin on Tuesday September 18 and Wednesday, September 19, 2012.
