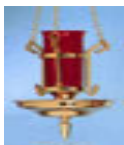

*The Anointing of the Sick involves using Oil of the Sick (“oleum infirmorum”) – olive oil blessed by the bishop at the Chrism Mass during Holy Week. Anointing with oil is not a magical or good-luck gesture but a sincere sign of supernatural assistance to coincide with the physical medicine and treatment already being given. Those suffering are reminded of St. Paul’s words: “Now I rejoice in my suffering for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what was lacking in the afflictions of Christ on behalf of his body, which is the Church,” (Colossians 1:24), and “For as Christ’s sufferings overflow to us, so through Christ does our encouragement also overflow,” (2 Corinthians 1:5). Catholic Christians firmly believe in redemptive suffering, whereby a person willingly offers up their personal aches and pains, trials and tribulations, with Christ on the Cross.*


