**Dear Parishioners,**  
***If a Catholic gets married by a justice of the peace, a mayor, a municipal clerk, a captain on a ship, a Protestant minister, or an Eastern Orthodox priest, a religious cult non-Christian minister (e.g., Jehovah Witness officiant or Mormon priesthood holder), and hasn't received a dispensation from a local Catholic Bishop, then that marriage is invalid, and the Catholic must not receive Holy Communion if they are to avoid sacrilegious mortal ("deadly") sins until that union is sanctioned by the Church in a convalidation. This situation often happens when a non-practicing Catholic (and they are legion) doesn't realize that a non-Catholic Christian minister can still marry the couple in a non-Catholic ceremony with the Catholic Church's blessing as long as the couple meets with a duly authorized priest or deacon or bishop and still fulfills all the same Pre-Cana preparations as everyone else...with the local Bishop's permission.***
