In many wedding preparations nowadays, brides often call the casterer first and a pastor or another priest last to set the date for the wedding, but it must be the other way around. Granted, caterers book up to 12 to 18 months ahead of time,

and photographers, florists, and other folks in the wedding business require months of advance notice to start making preparations. But the food, photos, and flowers aren't the required elements for the Sacrament of Matrimony, so it makes perfect sense to contact the Catholic church and the priest or deacon first—before making any other wedding plans. Besides, most dioceses require Catholics to meet with a priest or deacon beginning up to a year before the wedding. So if you're getting ready to walk down the aisle, make sure that you give your faith at least as much consideration as the decision to serve chicken or filet mignon.


