Dear Parishioners.

Any article of devotion or something integral to human life and activity can be blessed, but that doesn't mean that the medal, other religious item, car, home, pet dog, cat, boa constrictor, or tarantula becomes a lucky charm. The priestly or

diaconal blessing is merely a way of showing gratitude to God for his divine grace and putting these blessed items under his watchful care.

It is Palm Sunday, a.k.a Passion Sunday this weekend! On the Sunday before this Passion Sunday I answered a phone call from a person who wanted to know "when are palms given out" this weekend. I replied that Masses are at the usual times this Sunday at 7:30am, 9am, 11am, and 5pm. Some Catholics who don't attend Mass regularly or hardly at all get the dubious title of A&P (ashes and palms) Catholics, meaning they only come to church when freebies besides the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ are given out, as they are reminded by friends, acquaintances, or TV newscasters that it's either "Ash Wednesday" or "Palm Sunday" for Catholics and some other Christians. Thankfully, they're still a minority, likely even smaller in number than Catholics who fulfill their regular Sunday Mass attendance obligation religiously. Ashes and palms aren't magical. They're merely tangible symbols of a spiritual life.

Easter Food Basket Blessing - April 7

There is a custom in Poland for families to bring baskets of food to church to be blessed by the priest on Holy Saturday. We have continued this custom here at Holy Family. There will be a blessing of food for the Easter meal on Sat. April 7th at 12 Noon (Holy Saturday). The baskets usually contain colored eggs (that symbolize life,



spring, and the Resurrection), sausage or ham (that represents the passion of Christ), bread or Babka (that represents Christ, who is the bread of life), horseradish (representing the passion of Christ), salt (symbolizing prosperity), and butter (that represents good will).



RE-REGISTRATION 2012-2013

Parents with children in our religious education program should have received their re-registration forms **via mail for the 2012-2013** school year. Please make any necessary corrections and include the non-refundable registration fee (as instructed in the letter) by May 31, 2012.

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE. NEW REGISTRANTS 2012-2013

The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade. To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- Family MUST be registered in Holy Family parish.
- Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (located in the school).
- Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- A non-refundable registration fee as follows:
 1 Child \$100 2 Children \$150 3 or More \$180
- A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring. Grades 3 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.

REGISTRATION DATES & HOURS:

Hours starting April 1: Monday & Thursday 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Tuesday & Wednesday during normal class times. PLEASE NOTE THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION OFFICE IS CLOSED ON FRIDAYS. Classes begin on Tuesday September 18 and Wednesday September 19, 2012.
