Dear Parishioners,  
 Governments, clubs, organizations, families, and religions have rules and laws for the common good of their members. Whether for professional baseball or a friendly game of basketball in someone's driveway, a Knights of Columbus or Elks meeting or a session of Congress, all groups have rules of behavior to protect their members from possible abuse or neglect, as well as to preserve the unity and integrity of the whole group.

In addition, families --- even the smallest of them --- have their own laws to live by. Hughie must be home by 10pm on school nights, for example, or Barbie must always ask for mom or dad's permission before going to a friend's house for dinner.

The Church is considered the family of God, and rules exist to protect that family as a whole as well as the individual members. Specifically, Catholics are obligated to follow all the divine laws of God, the natural moral law (e.g., heterosexual marriage and the protection of unborn human beings), Church law (also known as canon law), and all the legitimate and ethical civil laws of their city, state, and nation as long as they don't contradict the laws of God or the Church. In short, a Catholic is expected to be a law-abiding citizen. This viewpoint is reinforced by what Christ said: "Render to Caesar what is Caesar and to God what is God's." (Mark 12:17)




