NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE.

NEW REGISTRANTS 2012-2013

The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade. To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- Family **MUST** be registered in Holy Family parish.
- Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (located in the school).
- **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
- A non-refundable registration fee as follows:
1 Child \$100 2 Children \$150 3 or More - \$180
- A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring. Grades 3 - 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.

Hours starting April 1: Monday & Thursday 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Tuesday & Wednesday during normal class times. PLEASE NOTE THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION OFFICE IS CLOSED ON FRIDAYS. Classes begin on Tuesday September 18 and Wednesday, September 19, 2012.
