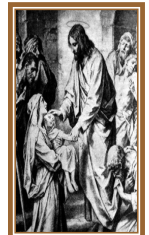

Dear Parishioners,
Deacons can baptize, witness marriages, perform funeral and burial services outside of Mass, distribute Holy Communion, preach the homily, and are obligated to pray the Divine Office (Breviary) each day. The Divine Office, Breviary, or Liturgy of the Hours are all the same thing. These are the 150 psalms and Scriptural readings from the Old and New Testament as well as selected early Christian writings that every deacon, priest, and bishop must pray every day and a few times during each day. This way, in addition to the Biblical readings at daily Mass, the cleric is also exposed to more Sacred Scripture each day of his life.

Permanent deacons, especially those who are married, have regular jobs to support their families and also help the local pastor or the pastor assigned by the bishop by visiting the sick, teaching the faith, counseling couples and individuals, working on parish committees and councils, and giving advice to the pastor.

Deacons, priests, and bishops are considered "clerics," members of the clergy, in the Catholic Church. A major qualification for a deacon, besides that of good or excellent Christian character, includes more than just a couple of years of sustained systemized study of theology (doctrine or dogma, Scripture, morality, and history) before ordination to the Order of the Diaconate.

NEW REGISTRANTS ONLY

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150 3 OR MORE \$180

5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
