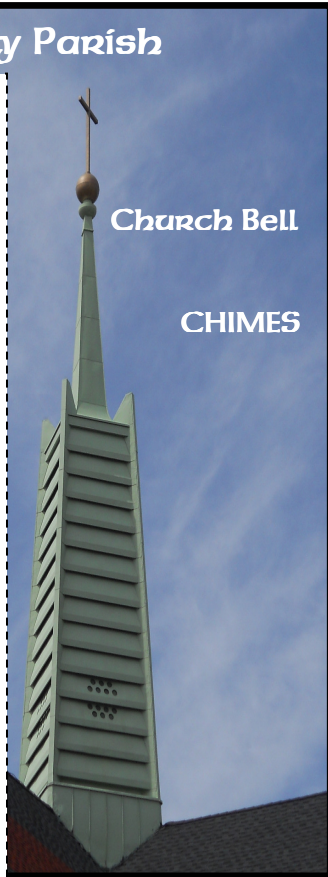
BELL CHIMES

 FundRun**

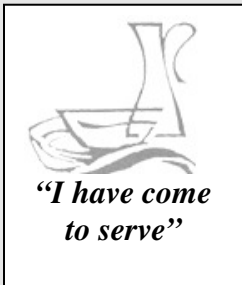
