

Dear Parishioners,

We have a deacon! Congratulations to Jim Neubauer, our dedicated parishioner who has served God and us as a cantor, extraordinary minister of the Eucharist, lector, and youth minister in particular, sharing that last mentioned responsibility with Adele Wright, who with Deacon

Jim goes above and beyond the call of duty, as it were, as two of our Holy Family community's informal and generous corps of volunteers in service to the People of God in Union Beach and Hazlet.

This weekend we celebrate Deacon Jim's first official Mass as deacon of the Liturgy of the Word & Eucharist. Along and after four years of study with fifteen other men of our four-county south central New Jersey diocese, Deacon Jim was ordained by our bishop, the Most Rev. David M. O'Connell, CM, at St. Mary of the Assumption Church in Trenton at a 10am Mass on Saturday, May 12. A permanent deacon is one ordained for service to the Church through his local bishop, and usually working at the parish level in conjunction with a priest, the pastor.

Deacon Jim is a recently retired career United States Marine, having served our nation through the Corps for more than three decades, and having attained and earned the rank of a full "bird" (actually, eagle) colonel, with his military occupational specialty ("MOS") in communications. Now he serves God in a special way through the Sacrament of Holy Orders as a deacon, having served our country actively in the military for over half his life. Deacon Jim's wife Debbie and son James Robert have in their husband and father a man of dedication, sacrifice, and extraordinary education, and they deserve our thanks for supporting him in his fouryear journey to serve his God and Church as a deacon. We thank Debbie and Jim for continuing to support Jim in his new vocation apart from and following his distinguished military service. As fourth child and second son of nine sisters and six brothers, he joins many of them in their work and lifestyle of religious life and medicine serving others, but as an ordained minister of the Word and Sacrament with the same responsibilities as priests with the exception of offering the Eucharist at Mass, absolving sins, and sacramentally anointing the sick and dying.

We welcome Deacon Jim to our parish and pray that he may have many happy and Spirit-filled productive years of service!

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY PHONE. NEW REGISTRANTS FOR 2012-2013

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Family <u>MUST</u> be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
- **2.** Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
- 3. Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).
- 4. A non-refundable registration fee as follows:

1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150 3 OR MORE \$180.00

- 5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
- 6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
- 7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.
