Church: (1) Attending Mass every Sunday and holyday of obligation, (2) Going to confession annually if not more often or when needed, (3) receiving Holy Communion worthily during the Easter season (receiving weekly or daily is recommended, though), (4) Observing laws on fasting and abstinence: one full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; not swallowing meat on Fridays during Lent, (5) Obeying the marriage laws of the Church, (6) Supporting the Church financially and otherwise.




