"I am wary of a solution that can be reduced to a kind of 'female machismo,' because a woman has a different makeup than a man," he said. "The Church cannot be herself without the woman and her role. The woman is essential for the Church. Mary, a woman, is more important than the bishops. I say this because we must not confuse the functions with the dignity."

Pope Francis, whose simple way of celebrating Mass has attracted criticism from traditionalist Catholics, also took up the controversial subject of liturav.

Pope Benedict XVI's 2007 decision to lift most restrictions on celebrating the Tridentine Mass "was prudent and motivated by the desire to help people who have this sensitivity," Pope Francis said. "What is worrying, though, is the risk of the ideologization of the (old Mass), its exploitation."

The pope also said that the liturgical reform that followed in the wake of the 1962-1965 Second Vatican Council is "absolutely irreversible."


