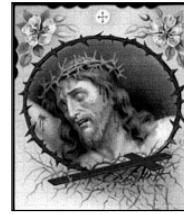

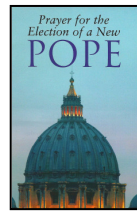

Dear Parishioners,

The Church is the People of God; the Body of Christ. The four marks, or signs, of the Church that distinguish it as the Church of Jesus are that it is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic. Christ governs, guides, and sanctifies the Church through the pope and his fellow bishops, who are successors of Peter and the apostles. The pope, the Bishop of Rome, resides in the 108-acre Vatican City State. The Roman Curia refers to the administrative arm of the Church. The pope and the curia are called the "Holy See." Some bishops are named cardinals by the pope, and rarely a priest (e.g., the late Jesuit Father Avery Dulles of Fordham University, convert son of U.S. Secretary of State John Foster Dulles), and together are referred to as the College of Cardinals. They advise the pope, lead dioceses or archdioceses, serve in the Curia, and before they reach the age of 80, participate in papal elections.

Popes occasionally issue letters to the universal church (pertaining to faith and morality) called "encyclicals." Ecumenical councils are gatherings of all the Church's bishops. The last one was the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965). Occasionally the pope convenes a synod, i.e., a meeting of selected bishops concerning a specific topic. The laws of the Church are contained in the Code of Canon Law.

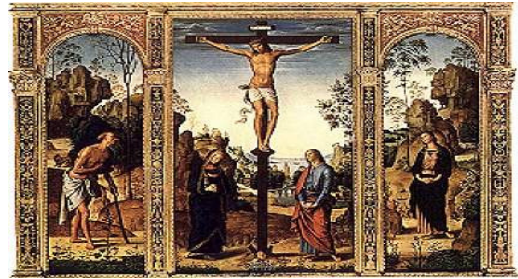

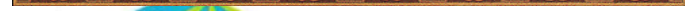
