Priests for Life: Most Significant Pro-life Legislative Development

"The most significant prolife legislative development since Roe vs. Wade has occurred. A ban on abortions nationwide after 20 weeks of development, based on the child's capability to feel pain, is being introduced in the US House of Representatives by Congressman Trent Franks of Arizona. (The bill is an amended version of H.R. 1797.) This kind of law has been successfully passed in nine states already. The awareness of late term abortion generated by the Kermit Gosnell case has accelerated the momentum behind this effort. Please encourage your Congressional Representative to support this bill."


SINGLES DANCE – JUNE 8 AT 7 P.M.
