**Promises of the Rosary
Sixth of Fifteen Promises**

6. Whosoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its Sacred Mysteries shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just he shall remain in the grace of God, and become worthy of Eternal Life.

This promise highlights the magnitude of Graces that the Rosary brings to whomever prays it. One will draw down God's Mercy rather than His Justice and will have a final chance to repent (see promise #7). One will not be conquered by misfortune means that Our Lady will obtain for the person sufficient Graces to handle said misfortune (i.e. carry the Crosses allowed by God) without falling into despair. As Sacred Scripture tells us, "For my yoke is easy and my burden light." ([Matthew 11:30](#))



NEW REGISTRANTS 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR

If you are a *new parishioner* and wish to register your children for our program, please call the religious education office at 732-264-7043 to make an appointment.

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (At school).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.
**1 CHILD \$100 2 CHILDREN \$150
 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00**
5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 7 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

Classes begin on Tuesday, September 17, & Wednesday, September 18, 2013. *Re-registrations are now closed for the 2013-2014 school year.*



He was ordained a PIME Priest in 1974. His mission assignment was to minister to the people in Japan and returned to the United States in 1984. He has been working in many mission locations since then.

The PIME Missionaries are Catholic priests and brothers who commit themselves to lifelong missionary service,



especially to non-Christians. (PIME stands for the Pontifical Institute for Foreign Missions in Latin.) Founded in Italy in 1850, PIME is an International Society of Apostolic Life with members serving in Algeria, Bangladesh, Brazil, Cambodia, Cameroon, Guinea-Bissau, Hong Kong, India, Italy, Ivory Coast, Japan, Mexico, Myanmar, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Thailand and the United States.
