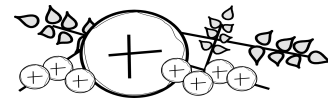
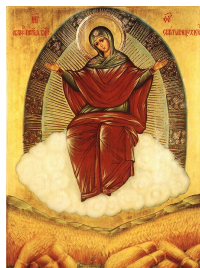

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: I Kings 19:4-8

Queen Jezebel had vowed to kill Elijah, who went into the desert and prayed for death. Instead he went to sleep and was awakened by an angel, who told him to eat the food God had given him. He ate and went back to sleep, but God's angel again woke him and told him to eat. Strengthened by the food, he got up and walked forty days and nights to the mountain of God.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:30—5:2

Paul appeals to the Ephesians to get rid of bitterness, anger, and malice. Instead they must be kind, compassionate, and forgiving just as God has been. We must be imitators of Christ, and love one another as he has loved us.

Gospel: John 6:41-51

The Jews were not convinced that Jesus was the bread that came down from heaven. But he again explains that he is the bread of life. He tells them that anyone who believes and eats this bread shall live forever. He explains that the bread he will give is his flesh, for the life of the world.

**MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL 2015
Second Collection August 8 & 9**

This year's Mission Cooperative Appeal will take place at all the Masses the weekend of August 8/9. Fr. Virgilio C. Alburo from the Diocese of Daet in the Phillipines will present the appeal. Fr. Alburo is a parish priest at St. Philip the Apostle at San Felipe, Basud, Camarines Norte, consisting of nine villages with 20,000 congregants. Only 25% of the annual high school graduates are able to afford to go onto higher education. The Diocese of Daet has created the "Helping Each Other Project" where skilled parishioners help train the remaining 75% of the high school graduates and the unemployed for future jobs. The construction of a building to facilitate this training has been initiated but to date, the funds for this project has been depleted with only 30% of the construction completed.

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

To register NEW STUDENTS in our religious education program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the religious education office (Under the church).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child.

1 CHILD \$100.00 2 CHILDREN \$150.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$180.00

5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin religious education is the year your child begins first grade.

Mother Teresa Regional School is excited to announce a scholarship opportunity for new families who register for the 2015-2016 school year.

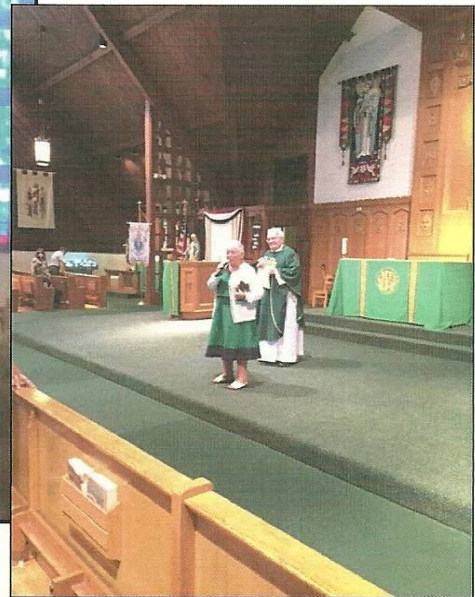
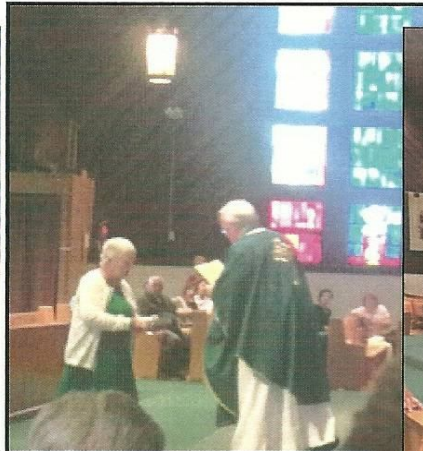
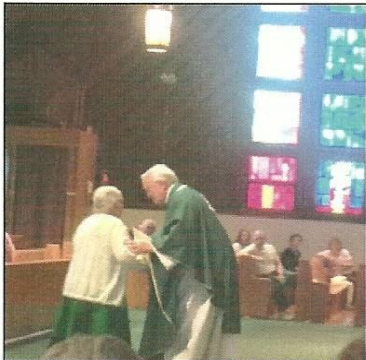
- Five families from the parish will be eligible to receive a scholarship worth \$1750.
